This program promotes workplace safety and health by increasing healthcare workers' recognition, avoidance, and prevention of workplace hazards. This program is intended for hospital staff from the following areas: employee safety, environment of care, workers compensation, engineering, facilities, administration, clinical care, risk management, human resources, and anyone involved in their hospital's safety program.
